## 貨運物流業要求政府盡快推出「防疫抗疫基金 3.0」

2020 年 8 月 13 日 (即時) 自一月新型冠狀病毒 (COVID-19) 爆發以來·疫情持續在全球蔓延·各 國採取的防疫抗疫措施,令經濟活動陷入停擺,環球供應鏈受阻延,香港作為區內的重要轉口港,各貨 運物流產業鏈的持份者,包括海陸空運輸、貨運代理、物流倉儲等均受到嚴重衝擊。

根據統計數字·今年香港首四個月的總貨運量已較去年同期下跌 4.3%·但較 2018 年則下跌 9%;當 中空運及陸路運輸的貨運量均錄得雙位數字的下跌 (11%及 14.5%); 至於貨櫃吞吐量‧則較 2019 及 2018年分別下跌 7.3%及 14%。

疫情肆虐,經濟前景不明朗,過去數月,付運貨物不是被取消就是延後發送,特別是非生活必須的消 費品·各物流產業鏈的持份者的收入大受影響·正面對營運資金不足的問題。近日香港疫情出現第三 波·内地加强跨境司機的監管·為免延誤·原經香港處理的跨境貨物亦改為由内地港口直接處理·進· 步加劇對香港貨運物流業的衝擊。由於疫情難以在短時間內在全世界消失,全面復工復產無期,若政府 未能加大紓困措施力度,估計全港從事貨運物流的 3000 家企業,有近半將會因財困問題而結業,23 萬的從業員中有三成的的員工,約7萬員工會受影響

貿易及物流業是香港四大支柱的主要行業之一、佔本地生產總值五分之一、並肩負支撐其他產業的發 展·對香港的經濟發展至為重要·一旦出現倒閉潮·日後或會出現物流服務瓶頸·影響本港貿易及物流 業的競爭力·窒礙發展。

自疫情爆發以來,政府先後推出各項收費及牌照費的寬減/豁免;呼籲銀行推出「還息不還本」的安 排;及「保就業」計劃等・上述措施確實有助減輕企業的財政負擔・但對於貨運物流業而言・租金還是 主要的成本,辦公室及倉儲的租金佔營運開支五至六成不等。在現時的困難時期下,業界希望政府除延 續先前的紓困措施外,還應盡快推出「防疫抗疫基金 3.0」,以支援業界,共渡時艱

貨運物流業界要求政府提供的紓困措施綜合如下:

- 1. 要求業主免租及管理費兩個月,政府向企業提供兩個月的租金及管理費補貼;
- 2. 所有政府各項收費繼續寬減/豁免六個月
- 3. 延長銀行各類「還息不還本」的安排半年;
- 4. 延長「保就業」計劃額外半年・並把65歲或以上沒有強積金戶口的員工納入計劃内;
- 5. 盡快推出「防疫抗疫基金 3.0」、延續先前各項的現金補貼、並進行補漏拾遺、確保前兩期 抗疫基金遺漏了的界別、能優先處理。






#### **SMART LOGISTICS Series I - Automated Data Collection**





On July 15, 2020 the association launched a webinar "Automated Data Collection" under the "SMART LOGISTICS" seminar series. There were Around 20 participated in the one hour to disseminate the latest development of the topic. Our treasurer Dr. Philip Lam (B.Math, UWat; M.IT. CSU; PhD. Curtin) shared an introductory topic to his research, applying RFID in logistics, and also invited Manager, Graphic Communication Services - Software, Product Strategy & Management, Mr. Nelson Wong from Fuji Xerox (Hong Kong) Limited to unleash their latest development of an automated data collection printer driver, namely Multi-channel Variable Data Platform and Solution (MVDP), for the logistics industry.

Overwhelming number of questions were asked in the Q&A session and members showed interests in the topic. It was expressed that the information shared was very different from the way data was collected traditionally in the logistics field. Comments were made to reflect how data collection could be improved, enabling further data communication with logistics partners.
