"The impact of COVID/Russo-Ukraine crisis on the global supply chain" Webinar on 2022.05.11



COVID started since 2019 as global pandemic, on Feb 2022 the Russo-Ukraine crisis added complexities and challenges to the vulnerable global supply chain.

As a result significant interruptions are observed on supply side. The congestion of ports, cancellation of passenger flights, lacking of ground crews, truck drivers, factory workers, etc all make the supply capacity drops tremendously across the globe.

To minimize the impact, we better to start the monitoring from the demand side as the shut down or social control of cities will affect the consumption accordingly.

Developing alternative sources can avoid delay in getting necessary components for critical production. Advance booking of carriers with Freight Forwarders and proper adjustment of tariff may help to stay in priority of the long queue. The world is also getting more regulated so reviewing license renewal will help to avoid last minute stockpile requirement as well. Reviewing the safety stock and identify anything idle along the supply chain may also help to release some buffer during the tough supply situation.




