Hong Kong Logistics Association (HKLA) is inviting interested parties to join the business mission to Bangkok, Thailand on 21-25 June 2023. The purpose of this business mission is to explore opportunities and establish partnerships with companies in Thailand to expand participants' global reach.

Our aim is to meet with key stakeholders in Thailand; including government authorities, associations, customers, and partners to identify mutually beneficial opportunities for collaboration and growth. This mission provide an opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of the local market and business culture, and to establish strong relationships with trusted partners who can help us to navigate the challenges.

Participants may apply for Trade and Industry Department (TID) SME Export Marketing Fund within 60 calendar days after the visit (subject to approval by TID). The maximum amount of funding support for each successful application is 50% of the trade mission.

Full support to the legislative amendments to allow direct transshipment
of e-cicarette and related substances
by multi-model means via the Hong Kong International Airport

The Hong Kong Logistics Association would like to offer the full support to the legislative amendment announced today to allow secured logistics operation for the e-eigarette and related substances to be transshipped through Hong Kong.

It is clear that direct transshipment through Hong Kong is in response to the demand of the Hong Kong air freight industry which is the part of the function of our logistics hub. Its spinoff economic benefits cannot be undereshmated.

We are convinced that our Customs and Excise Department can ensure the e-cigarette and related substances transshipped through Hong Kong international Airport in a secured manner. The secured transshipment logistics operation has been carried out in different forms and local domestic consumption is not anticipated. However, allowing this kind of business will greatly benefit our logistics industry after COVID period and current competitive situation. The proposed amendment is critical for the survival of the industry and the Government has done a good proactive action to support our logistics industry.

Hong Kong economy is on the course of recovery so the any proactive action is highly appreciated by the Association and more importantly it is not at the expense of concerned health issue.


