Seminar: Crime Prevention for Logistics Industry on 21 Aug 2018

Cyber security, frauds and criminal cases are found increasing nowadays. Logistics industries cannot stay away from such social phenomenon. HKLA has organized a free seminar for members on "Crime Prevention for Logistics Industry" and is glad to have Mr. Dicky Wong (Detective Senior Inspector of the Cyber Security and Technology), and Ms. Winnie Wong (Station Sergeant of the Crime Prevention Bureau of Hong Kong Police Force) to present talks on the subject of "Cyber Security and Crime Prevention relating to logistics operations". Both speakers shared with the participants valuable knowledge about cyber security issues and practical ways and means to prevent common crimes in logistics operations. There were over 40 participants attending the seminar and their feedback was inspiring and informative. The Q&A session was another highlight in the seminar. Thanks to the two great speakers of the Crime Prevention Bureau of Hong Kong Police Force, the seminar was well appraised by the participants.

Seminar: Improving Logistics Operations Performance KPI Design & Application on 31 Aug 2018



A 2.5 hours seminar on the subject "Improving Logistics Operations Performance – KPI Design & Application" was held, and the speaker was Dr. Alex Tang. Participants were senior managers and executives of global and SME logistics firms and logistics department of public listed organizations. In the seminar, Alex shared with participants the importance of measuring the performance of logistics operations aiming to improve the satisfaction levels of logistics service users internally and externally. The skills to design Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) and the difference between leading and lagging indicators were discussed. Participants had shown high interest in obtaining off-the-shelf a set of contemporary KPIs that can be immediately used in their logistics operations serving as a standard model to measure all logistics service performance. This may imply that there is urgent need to improve the logistics service quality to satisfy the customers and to gain new competitive advantages. Overall, the seminar was well appraised by the participants.

Seminar: Digital Disruption across the Supply Chain 27 Sep 2018



- The Speaker Mr. Mark Millar shared extensive insights into how disruptive technologies are gaining momentum across mainstream business operations.
- Initially reflecting on the dramatic impact of technology in the consumer sector during the last decade, he presented examples of how business in general and supply chains specifically are becoming digitally disrupted.
- Disruptive technologies are becoming more prevalent within the warehouse, in production and across all transport modes with the advent of autonomous vehicles – on the roads, in the air and across the seas.
- The burgeoning LogTech sector (logistics technology) is empowering access for new entrants and has the potential to disintermediate established business models in trucking, freight forwarding and logistics.
