The 10th International Logistics Case Study Workshop / Competition – Korea on 29 June - 6 July 2019

The purpose of this four-day competition was to prepare students to real problem-solving situations in the Logistics context.

The brief morning session started with the introduction by HKLA President, Ir. Elsa Yuen, followed by Ir. Dr. Owen Yue, who summarised the competition objectives. All participating Universities made icebreaking presentations emphasising on their program expectations on the first day.

On the following days, we visited DB Schenker, Korea Air Cargo, Lotte Mart and LF Logistics. It was very fruitful because we had the opportunity to observe different warehousing operations from manual to entirely automatic. During the visits, we had to detect if any malfunctions were occurring and later that day we had to give an oral presentation of the identified problems.

On the last day, we presented our recommendations to the judges. All teams did a great job showing a significant improvement on how to identify, analyse and provide multiple solutions. For me, it was an excellent experience to participate because I stepped out of my comfort zone, which helped me to be more creative. I recommend it to all students.
