Super Terminal 1 --- I was always curious to see how powerful the terminal was. It was a great opportunity for me to join HKLA for a visit to this Terminal - Hong Kong Air Cargo Terminals Limited (HACTL).

Guided to visit the facility, we looked at different areas, including the warehouses for bulk cargo and large shipments, the loading and unloading bays, and the apron. We observed how efficient the cargoes could be transported up and down in entire automation with up-to-date technology. In addition, the good layout design of the

six-storey infrastructure optimizes the dynamics of the cargoes. I was particularly amazed by the efficiency of their logistics system. For instance, it is possible for express cargoes to be sent to the terminal within the last 50 minutes before the scheduled time of departure. The



team would have to coordinate and carry out security checks before transferring the cargoes to the apron and load them onto the freighter just in time.

Seminar – Balancing the Demand and Supply in the Dynamic Market using Theory of Constraints (TOC) Method



On August 2, a training session on 'balancing the Demand and Supply in the dynamic market using Theory-Of-Constraints method "was conducted by Ir. Patrick Lee, Council Member of HKLA. In this seminar, a Theory-Of-Constraints based model to manage the volatile market demand of high technology products at the up-stream supply chain was introduced. This model has been adopted by a global US high technology glass manufacturing company. It is a useful practical tool to manage the dynamic high-technology customers' demand. The participants were active in discussion in the seminar.

Seminar – Emerging Technologies in Logistics and Supply Chain Management

Data, information and knowledge are critical assets of the performance of logistics and supply chain management (SCM), because they provide the basis upon which management can plan logistics operations, organize logistics and supply chain (SC) processes, coordinate and communicate with business partners, conduct functional logistics activities, and perform managerial control of physical flow of goods, information exchange and sharing among SC partners. The recent training seminar on "Emerging Technologies in Logistics and Supply Chain Management" was launched on Saturday 3rd

August 2013 conducted by Mr. Simon Chan, Council Member of HKLA. In this seminar, the emerging technologies applications in logistics and SCM such RFID, wireless technologies etc. were first introduced. Then, we discussed the pros and cons of using these applications, and finally we discussed a strategic framework and strategies for the adoption of these technologies in SCM context. After the seminar, there were good interactive discussions between the participants and the trainer. Comments received from the participants were positive. Members also provided their valuable suggestions on the related visits to be provided by HKLA for logistics practitioners in the future.

Seminar – Wine Label Law, Packaging and Logistics



Hong Kong became a "Free Port" for wine in Asia as the wine customs duty was abolished in the year 2008 thus making Hong Kong as one of the world's great "Wine-Hubs" in wine trading and distribution.

The big growth of wine business motivates and creates more unexpected new business growth, such as wine education; wine appreciation; wine pairing; wine delivery; wine storage; wine distribution and wine logistics.

HKLA invited Mr. Thomas Tam, one of our Council Members, to conduct a talk on wine. The major topic was "What is Wine?", "Wine Labeling systems of major wine producing countries" and "Different kinds of wine packaging". Related matters such as wine expertise introduction, information on wine auctions and inspection on wine condition was also included.

A case sharing on ordering wine from overseas was discussed and shared with the audience and guests.
