On 29th Nov 2013, our Past President (2005-2008) Mr. Anthony Wong attended the 2013 Asian-Pacific Logistics Federation (APLF) Council Meeting in Sydney, Australia on behalf of the Association. APLF was established in November of 1995 by logistics organizations from countries in the Asia-Pacific region. The participating countries are Australia, China, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand, Singapore, and Hong Kong. All participating countries recognized the importance of collaboration amongst the Asian logistics & Supply Chain practitioners because "The Asia Pacific region is the future for the global arena where the action will be, and APLF need to stay united and steadfast in order to grow our membership into the future". Out of the various proposals discussed, the introduction of the certification program – Certified Logistics & Supply Professionals (Asia Pacific) will bring significant benefits to the Association as well as the practitioners. HKLA Council has agreed to set up a special working team to implement this program.

(The eight member institutions are City University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Baptist University, Lingnam University, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong Institute of Education, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, and The University of Hong Kong.)
