Seminar - Warehouse Operations in Practice

We had a good turnout rate in April of this year for the same topic. The second seminar was therefore organized. Some basic warehouse operation flow such as goods receiving, putting away, picking, packing, and dispatching were introduced. The use of appropriate material handling equipment was recommended in order to facilitate the warehouse operations. Other warehouse related functions such as stock taking, damaged goods handling, occupational safety, security, and staff training etc. were elaborated too. The objective was to share with the frontline warehouse operators the information and technical knowhow of running a warehouse in general. There was Q & A section at the end of the seminar where the audience could discuss and share with others about their operational issues. We hope similar topics would be welcome by our members in future.

The Building Warehouse Physical Infrastructure seminar was designed to provide some local expertise on how to build the warehouse physically with the aim to further articulate how the costs or prices were calculated for operating a warehouse. The layout and use of different material handling equipment to meet the purpose of minimizing the overall costs were also recommended. The temperature control facility specifications and designs were covered. The lecture room was packed with attentive audience and some follow up calls in the next few days were also

received for further discussion. It was nice to meet all the enthusiastic participants and some very senior managers in the seminar.

The visit was warmly welcomed by the members who enthusiastically raised their questions and exchanged their technical experiences with the staff of the Post Office from the beginning to the end of the visit.

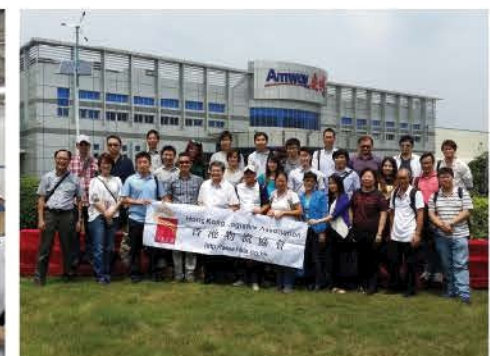
