電台訪問 有關香港物流業的挑戰及發展



本會會長陳鏡治先生於六月份時接受新城財經台「香樹輝 King King 傾」節目訪問，談及現時本港物流業所面對的挑戰及將來的發展，有關訪問重點如下：



陳會長認為本港物流業未來的情況會比以往差。除面對工資及租金成本上升的壓力外，本港勞動人口不足等都是嚴重問題，對本港物流業的競爭力有一定程度的影響。但物流業是必需的行業，不能單看跨境物流服務，本地亦有物流服務需求。

有關中韓兩國簽定貿易協定對本港物流業的影響，陳會長認為多屬消費品方面，受歡迎之韓國貨品例如化妝護膚品、服裝及電子消費品等，價值雖高，但實體物流以體積和重量計算，縱使有影響但總量上不會很大。其次是韓國貨物是從多途徑進入大陸，甚或經灰色渠道，加上現時稅率不高，因此中韓兩國的貿易協定對本港物流業的影響也不致很大。

而對於政府將於葵青區提供十五公頃物流用地的計劃，陳會長表示業界的看法都認為土地供應仍然不足，若政府的批地面積太小，在其上興建多層式倉庫效率會不高。希望政府將來批地時，每塊批地面積可有七至十公頃，並以單一地塊式發展較為有經濟效益。

最後，陳會長認為由於活化工廈，許多工廠大廈可以改變用途，包括使用作為貨倉，但工廈設計與貨倉不同，對物流運作有很多不便和不能標準化。雖然有所舒緩，始終都未能取代真正的物流貨倉。
