- 3.) **Cold Chain Logistics Committee** is a newly established committee to align with the theme of our 2016 Logistics Forum i.e. "The Role of Cold Chain Logistics in E-Commerce". Our goal is to pursue further development in the cold chain business logistics by different ways and means such as to build operations standards, safety guidance, temperature-control regulating devices, SOP documentation, general knowledge on arbitration, etc.

On the other hand, during my new term, I will closely work together with the great team i.e. the Council Members and the committees to further enhance our services not only for the HKLA members but also the logistics industries through various existing and new initiatives, programs and activities. Externally, I will invite and network with industrial experts to join the association or partnering with them to make sounding voices for Hong Kong logistics industries. I sincerely invite all our members to actively participate in the HKLA programs and events, and take advantage of the services that are specially offered to you.

2017 Hong Kong Logistics Case Competition on 11-12 Feb 2017



There were 16 teams of candidates accompanied by 3 mentors from different logistics expertise and 8 experienced tutors to study the warehouse operations of Yatai Integrated Logistics Limited. This is the first time that YSHKLA arrange the case competition in an overnight camping format, allowing participants to work together without interruption at Po Leung Kuk Tai Tong Campsite.



Through an intensive 36 hours on site study, each team presented their findings and total solutions to the judging panel formed up by Mr. Benjamin Sezo and Mr. Raymond Siu from Yatai, and Dr. Alex Tang from HKLA.

As one of the mentors, I have a strong impression that guidance to the teams is essential for taking up a right direction on problem solving, and to develop a sounding solution on time.

The Case Competition has provided a refreshing experience for the students and young members, beyond lecture rooms. The students had a wonderful opportunity to immerse in a real-life situation about logistics problem solving and also learned how to work as a team within a short time frame.
